Hierarchy of controls - Slips

- Floor contamination
 - ◆ Contamination eliminated or controlled
 - ◆ Correct cleaning regime inc. spillages

- Suitable floors
 - ◆ Floors slip-resistant
 - ◆ Appropriate use of: mats, treatments

- Footwear
 - ◆ Slip resistant?

Containing oil leaks



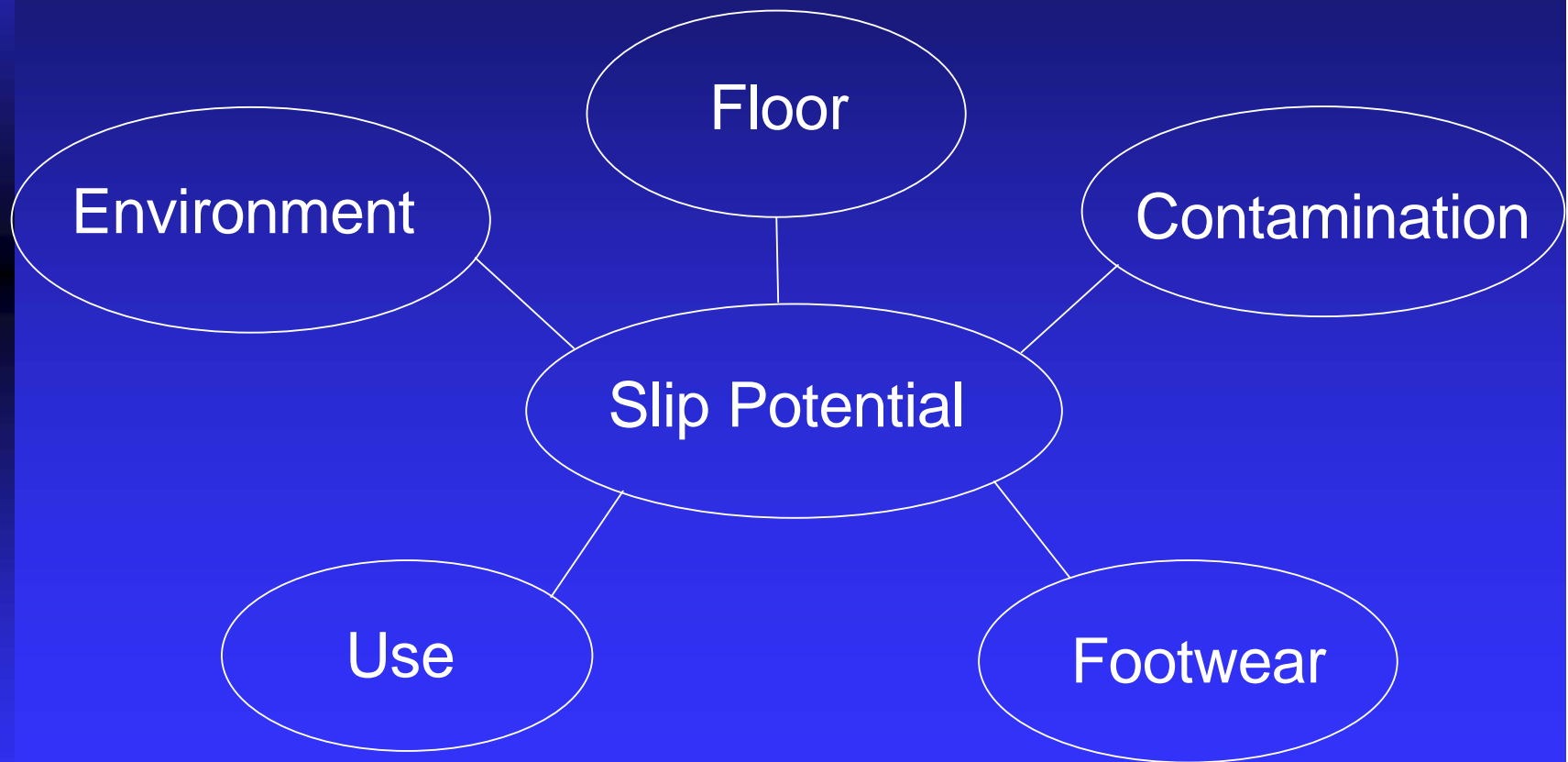

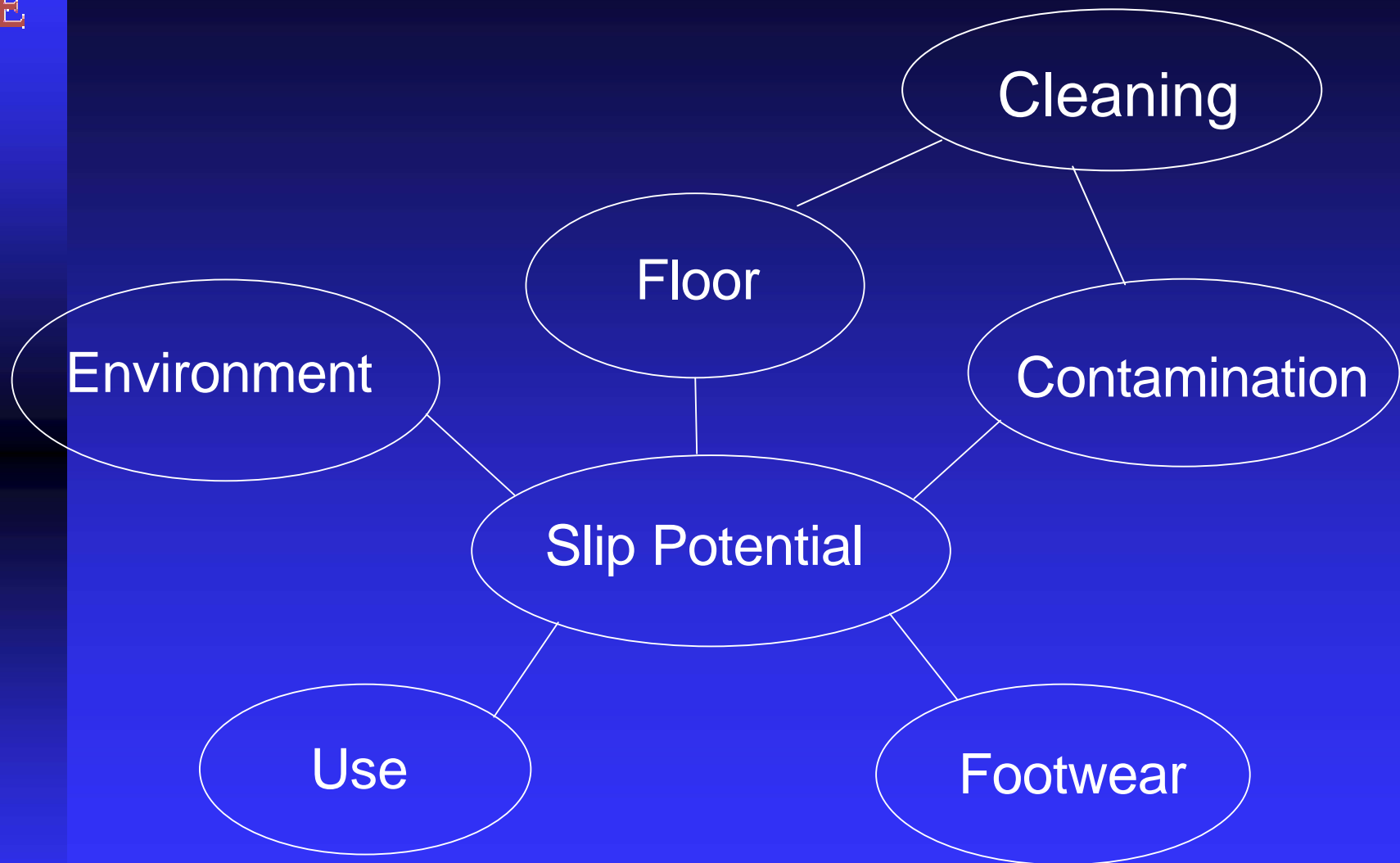


Dry contamination

Cleaning – clear walkway



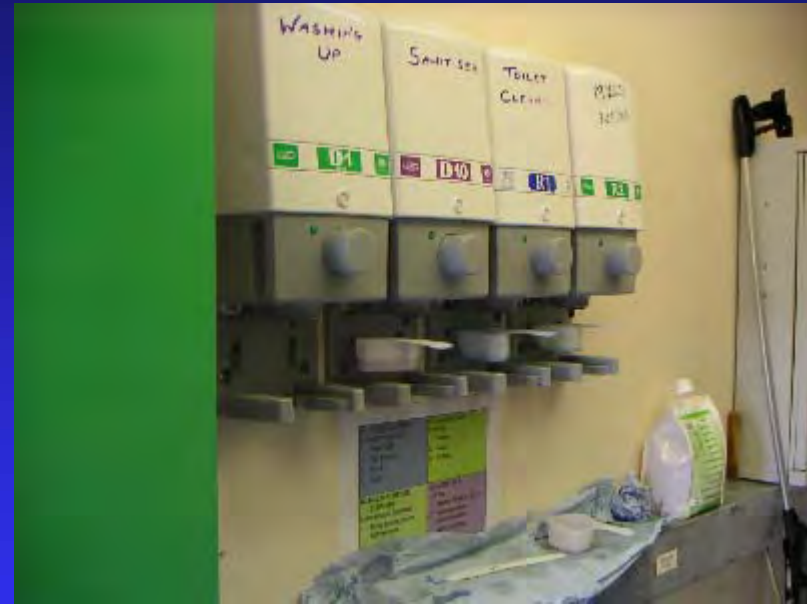
Clear walkway??????
